15 MINUTES

MADE TO MOVE

an activity that uses a preschooler's natural desire to move to help



1. FOLLOW

WHAT YOU NEED: No supplies needed.

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Have the children stand behind you.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Move around the room and ask the children to follow you. Move quickly around chairs, tables, and through doors if possible. Be creative on where you move and make it fun!

BIBLE STORY

God is always with me.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Follow me wherever I go!"

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Great job! You stayed with me, wherever I went! Today, we'll hear a Bible story about someone who is always with us, no matter where we go."

TRANSITION: Move to Worship and Story by extending the activity and asking the children to follow you as you move to the story area.

PROVIDING TIME FOR FUN INTERACTION 15 MINUTES

MADE TO EXPLORE

an activity that channels a preschooler's innate curiosity into a discussion of the week's crucial concepts



2. ONE SENSORY BIN

WHAT YOU NEED: One medium-sized toy truck, several small toy cars, shredded paper, and a medium-sized bin

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Place the shredded paper in the tub. Hide all of the cars and the truck in the paper.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Encourage the children to stick their hands in the tub and try to find the ONE truck.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "There is ONE truck in the bin. Let's see if we can find it!" (*Point to the bin.*)

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "Reach in the bin and see what you can find. If you find something that is not a truck, put it back in the bin. We are only looking for the ONE truck." (*Do activity.*)

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Nice work! You found the one truck. Today, we'll hear a Bible story about the ONE true God. WOW! I am so excited!"

TRANSITION: Move to Worship and Story by taking ONE giant step at a time as you walk to the story area.

3. MEMORY VERSE WITH MOTIONS

[HEAR FROM GOD | MEMORY VERSE REVIEW]

WHAT YOU NEED: No supplies needed.

WHAT YOU DO:

STORY

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Say the memory verse and do

the following motions in front of the children. "Trust in the Lord (point up) with all (arms out wide) your heart," (hands over heart) Proverbs 3:5. (Open hands like a book.)

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Say the verse again with the motions and invite the children to do it with you. Repeat several times.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "I will say our new memory verse. Everyone, watch me!

"'Trust in the Lord (point up) with all (arms out wide) your heart,' (hands over heart) Proverbs 3:5." (Open hands like a book.)

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "Now, let's do it together! Are you ready?

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Our memory verse tells us that we can always trust God! Who can trust God? I can trust God!"

4. DOUGH PEOPLE

[TALK ABOUT GOD | BIBLE STORY REVIEW]

**Be sure to list the items you will be using today on the "Allergy Alert Poster" and post it at the door to your room.

WHAT YOU NEED: "Allergy Alert Poster," cardstock, and Play Doh®.

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Copy "Allergy Alert Poster" on cardstock and hang on the door.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Show the children how to roll the dough into balls for heads and "worms" for bodies. Make three heads and three bodies for Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. Make a fourth head and body for the angel.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Talk about how God was always with Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "I'm so happy to see you today! Come sit with me at the table. We're going to make dough people!"

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "First, I want you to roll some dough like this and make three balls. (*Demonstrate then count the balls.*) These are the heads of our dough people.

"Now, roll the dough like this and make three little worms. (Demonstrate then count the "worms.") These are the bodies of our dough people.

"Okay, let's line up our bodies and put a head on each one. (*Demonstrate.*) One, two, three! We have three dough people. Let's pretend they are Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego from our Bible story.

"But wait! There was someone else with Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego: the angel! God sent an angel to keep Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego safe. Let's make one more dough person for the angel.

"There! Now we have Shadrach, Meshach, Abednego, and the angel."

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego trusted that God was always with them, and so can you! So, when I ask, 'Who can trust God?', I want you to say, 'I can trust God!' Ready? Who can trust God? I can trust God! Yay! I can trust God!"

5. IN THE FURNACE

[LIVE FOR GOD | APPLICATION ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: "In the Furnace" and "Furnace Labels" Activity Pages; cardstock; dessert paper plates; red, orange, and yellow circle stickers; scissors; glue sticks; Avery® labels #5160 or equivalent, and a permanent marker

BIBLE STORY

God is always with me.

SHADRACH, MESHACH, ABEDNEGO DANIEL 3:1-28

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Copy "In the Furnace" on cardstock and cut out, one cutout per child. Copy "Furnace Labels" on Avery labels #5160 or equivalent. Cut paper plates in half, one half per child. Write child's name on the back of their plate.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Encourage children to add stickers all over the plate then glue the "SMA and the Shadow" Activity Page on their plate. Place the "Furnace Label" on their plate.

WHAT YOU SAY:

God? I can trust God."

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Hello friends, sit with me at the table."

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Review the Bottom Line.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "In our Bible story, we heard God is always with us. God sent an angel to keep Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego safe in the furnace. Let's make a picture of the furnace. Add these circle stickers to your plate. (*Pause.*) This is the fire in the furnace. Now glue this picture in the middle of your plate. Who do you see in the picture? Yes, it's Shadrach, Meshach, Abednego, and the angel. (*Pause.*) Great job! There they are, safe in the fire."

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "King Nebuchadnezzar thought he was a great king and built a huge statue. He wanted everyone to bow down to it when music played. But Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego were friends of God, and they knew that they should not bow down to anyone other than the one true God. The king got mad and threw Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego into the fire. They weren't alone. There was a fourth person in the fire with them. God sent an angel to keep them safe. When the king saw they were not hurt, he called them out of the fire. Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego trusted God. God was with them and saved them. We can trust that God is with us. Who can trust
